

## **ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY STATEMENT**

- Improve the visual appearance of our operational sites by careful siting of enclosures, structure and the deployment of operational plant in the local environment and respect wild life habitats.

This statement of policy will be reviewed and revised as appropriate, by the Managing Director and senior management to take account of changes in circumstances or in legal requirements and to ensure its continued effectiveness.
